Supplies

- Roll of solvent resistant tape (4 5)
- 70 durometer blade squeegee, 17' (3 4 5)
- Ulano TZ direct photo emulsion (3 4 5)
- 8 or 32 oz. Hunt Speedball Screen Filler (3 or Asels Art)

Inks

Hunt Speedball Permanent Acrylic Inks: (3 4 Asels)

Suggested colors:

- 8 oz. • Black Ink
• Process Cyan
• Process Magenta
• Dark Red
• Ultra Blue
- 16 oz. • Extender of Transparent Base
• White Ink
• Medium Yellow Ink

Can be combined with:

- Createx Pure Pigments (any size set) and • Lyntex medium (1)

Special Effects Ink Options:

- Golden Metallic, Pearlized, Interference, etc.
- Acrylic Paint combined with a retarder added (or use dry pigments added to a print base)

Misc. Supplies

- 1 gallon Ulano Stencil Remover No. 4 (3 4) (or household bleach)

- 1 qt. Acetone
- Exacto knife with #11 blades
- Utility scissors
- 1/2" masking tape
- 1/2" clear (ex. Scotchbrand) cellophane tape
- Old mixing spoons or sticks (to stir and mix paints)
- Work apron
- Paper cups covered with saran wrap or small jars for ink mixing and storage
- 3 rolls Viva paper towels
- Heavy-duty rubber gloves
- Fingernail scrub brush
- Large cellulose sponge
- Inexpensive paint bucket
- 1 qt. Denatured alcohol (**Ace**)
- Mr. Clean All Purpose Cleaner (the green solution)
- Mr. Clean Soft Scrub
- Portable hair dryer
- Extension cord
- Old newspapers
- Newsprint pad, 18 x 24'
- Mat board or cardboard scraps

Optional Supplies:

- Spray Adhesive

Paper & Printing Supplies

- 50 Sheets Rives BFK, or Arches Cover paper, 22 x 30" (**1 2 3 4**)
or substitute with any heavy stock cover paper that will not wrinkle with the moisture from our water based inks. Experiment with a variety before you buy.

Optional Equipment Needed to Set Up a Home Studio

- Printing Base (cost = \$50)

To make it get:

- Jiffy Hing Clamps (**Dick Blick**)
- 3/4" covered plywood (lumber co.)
- Bolts with nuts and washers

- Screen Printing Exposing Unit (cost = \$200)

(includes a 10" reflector light, post and stand. Accommodates a No. 1 or 2 photoflood bulb.)

- High Pressure washer available at Home Depot (cost = \$ 150)

Frames

Order from Victory Factory (Max. size 24 x 34" fits our exposing unit) with 1 1/2 x 3/4" Woodstock and #137 or 156 (orange or white) Pecap Swiss Monofilament.
